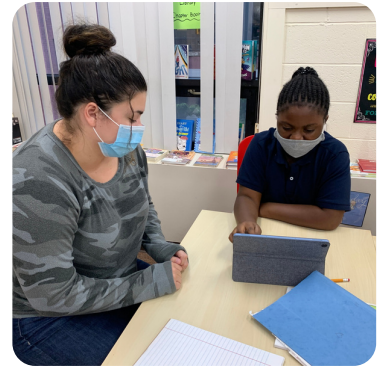


Resources
